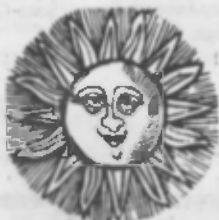

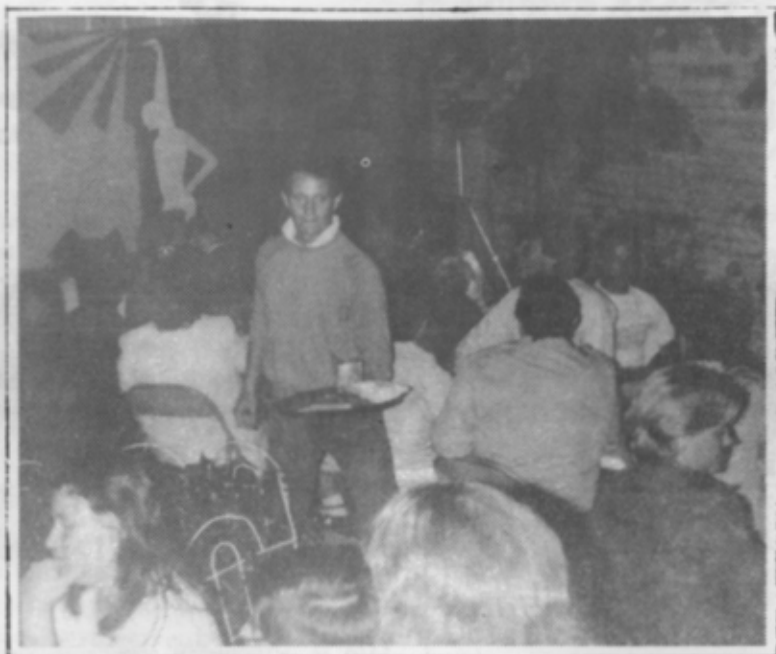

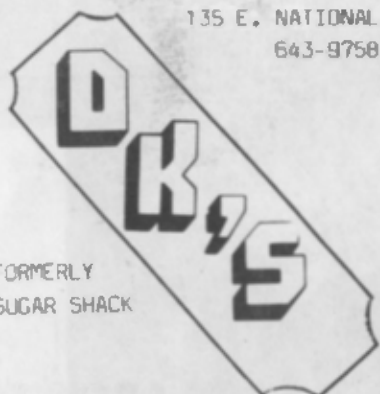

KEY WEST: A HISTORY, CHARM & ROMANCE

PART ONE

"Now please don't hurry down here:...Almost no one plays Bridge and there is almost nothing to do but drink or swim or..."

Pirates, seclusion, international markets, conch houses, art, nature, beauty, nightlife, relaxation, festivals, warmth----- these are the elements of a by-gone era, as well as a part of the present charm of that most often-sought Gay Winter destination

---KEY WEST---

During previous periods in North American history, Key West has often been the secret hideaway for individuals who did not seek to keep pace with the mainstream society in which they lived..... pirates, smugglers, exiled Tories, shrimpers, sailors, 60's hippies, and Gays. I'm not saying that we are among this varied group because of our activities, but more accurately, because of our "independent" thinking, and a need for a place where we can be ourselves comfortably without threats of retaliation.

Long-steeped in international involvement, Key West was occupied originally by Indians who referred to the island as *Caya Musteo* or, *Isle of Bones*, after a mountain of bones was discovered, probably the result of a supposed past massacre. Ponce de Leon and Juan Lafitte also were reported to have contributed to the island's colorful local history.

More positive elements of Key West's interesting history include periodic residences by famous creative people such as Hemingway, Audubon, Hotchner, Williams, Schneider, Kirkwood, and Klein, to name but a few.

Architecture in this jewel of a town, varies, with the city divided into 2 sections, Old Town & New Town. As the names suggest, Old Town is a preserved, restored section of Old Key West characterized by old Victorian homes, many of them fine Gay guest houses. This Victorian influence is a result of the remaining Tories returning home from the Bahamas after a frustrated attempt at establishing a new life for themselves failed. Those "conch" houses were a blend of Victorian, Bahamian, and New England-style. Many of the designs were influenced by the carpenters brought by the Tories.

ACQUIRED IMMUNE DEFICIENCY SYNDROME (AIDS)

WHAT IS AIDS?

Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) is a breakdown in the body's ability to fight off diseases. AIDS was initially recognized in previously healthy, young, homosexually active men, Haitians, IV drug users, and others. The first signs may be the development of a skin cancer Kaposi's sarcoma, or a severe pneumonia, Pneumocystis carini pneumonia.

WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS?

Swollen glands (lymph nodes) in the neck, armpit, or groin that may, or may not be painful, and have been present for months.

Red to purplish blotches bumps or spots, usually painless occurring on or under the skin, inside the mouth, nose, eyelids, or rectum, that do not go away.

Persistent white spots or unusual blemishes in the mouth. Weight loss of more than 10lbs. in 2, or less, months for unknown reasons.

Fevers (greater than 99°) or drenching night sweats that may occur on and off, and last for several days to weeks.

Severe tiredness unrelated to exercise, tension, or drugs.

Long & Persistent dry cough or shortness of breath, unrelated to smoking, that has lasted too long to be from a usual respiratory infection or cold.

Persistent diarrhea unexplained by other causes.

Personality changes, memory loss, confusion, or depression unexplained by other causes.

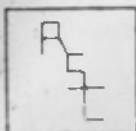
