Gay Life in Rural Wisconsin by Jerome M. (cont'd from issue #5)

Without hesitating I gladly got into the vehicle. Now that I look back on the situation my mitial comment must have sounded so corny, 'what's up?" I blusted out. His reply, "that's up to you" just went directly over my head. As he draws out of the parking lot I was verbally expressing my disappointment as to the time of night and the restaurant closing. Then, with more of my stagicity, I said, 'hey, my care back in the parking lot." He casually said, "six more hours from now, when WE get out of hert, it'll still be there, I'll run you back out for it " As I reflected over the word WE it became quite apparent that I should reposition myself as my brain and bormones were kicking

More prominent than the sound of the radio was the ailence that came between us. I recognized the streets on which we were turning and an eager anticipation over came me. I'd been at his bome with all my straight friends, several sugmer cooknuts, many winter parties. I never would have guessed. Then, panic, he couldn't really be bringing me back to his house, my stater's best friend would be there, his WIFE.

I thank him for teaching me that even though it was force of habit as a birth control precaution.

Though call after call I never got together with him again, then he steeped calling. I saw to it that I was always husy when Carol would invite me to a gathering. I owod her that, I owed both of them that countery. Two years later he left her anyway, he wasn't so careful that time. Carol is still incurcerated and each year a memorial ad runs for bim and most times in another column of the paper one appears for his very young triend. That night could be a novel of it's own.

Lemon Garlic Chicken Thighs

The secret to getting the outside of these chicken thighs so crispy and kneping the inside so juicy, is that they bake on a rack at a rather high temperature. Use a cooling rack in a shallow one for perfect results. The tomatoes add a contrasting natural sweetness to the lemony chicken.

For 4 servings you will need: 8 chicken thighs, juice of 1 lemon, 1 clove rarlic (crushed, half tsp dried thyme leaves, white peoper, 10 cherry tematoes, 2 thsp butter or margarine Wash and pat dry chicken. Place chicken in a bowl, tons the things with the mixture of the lemon juice. crushed gardic and thymn. Refrigerate for 2 hours or more, turo nieces at last once. Place thighs on a rack in a baking pan, akinside up. Sprinkle with salt and pepper. Bake at 425 degrees for shout 30 minutes. Halve cherry tumatues. Melt butter, add tomatoes, cook 1 to 2 minutes to heat through. Put chicken on service platter, spoon on sauteed tomatoes. This chicken calls for a good spaghette cooked aldcate and then tossed with butter, chopped paraley, and sprinkled with grated Parmesan cheese. YOUR RIGHT TO DIRECT YOUR FITTURE BEALTH CARE

You have the right to make decisions

about your health ours. This includes the right to accept or refuse medical or sprejical treatment. You also have the right to plan and direct the types of health care you may receive in the future if you become unable to extwens your wishes. You can do this by making an advance directive.

February 10, 1994

An action directive tells, in writing, your choices about the treatments you want or do not want or about how benth care decisions will be made for you if you become incapacitated and rannot express your wishes.

An advance directive express YOUR personal stishes and is bused upon your beliefs and values. When you make an advance directive, you will crossider issues like dying, living an long as possible, being kept alive on machines, being independent, and quality of life.

If you are 18 years of age or older and of 'sound mand', you can make an advance directive.

An advance directive speaks for you when you are unable to do so. Because it tells others the care and

treatments you do or do not want and/or who will make health care decisions for you when you cannot express your wishes, it may relive your family from the burden of guessing what you would want.

There are two ways to make a formal advance directive. You can complete either a "living will" or a "power of atterney for health care, document. These forms may be available from your health care provides or can be obtained from the Division of Health Department, Milwaukee County.

You do not need a lawyer to complete these forms. however, two persons must witness your regenture to these forms. The forms themselves describe who may or may not be a witness. You may also express your wishes using other forms and do not have to use these formal documents to make an advance directive.

A living will informs your physician that you want to the naturally if you develop an illness or injury that cannot be cared. It tells your physician that, when you are near death or in a Continued On Page # 13 Col 1
