SEND LOYE LETTERS GRYS ASKED:

[Raleigh M.C.] (AP) (Edited) The Gay and Lesbian Aliance Against Defination asking Gay men and Lesbians to send conservitave Sen. Jesse Helms "love letters" that describe what is "900d, Positive, challanging and special" about being homosexual. The group is expecting a strong response to the campaign directed at the North Carolina Republican known for his opposition to Gay legislation. "" We don't expect to change his mind, but ... we want to level the Playing field as far as understanding about who Gays and Lesbians are versus Who Helms says Gays and Lesbians are," Timothy Lane, a spoksman for GLHAD, said.

''Is not a 'bash Jesse' operation. It's quite the opposite," said Lame in a telePhone interview from GLAAD's New York office. "Each letter to Jesse should be a Personal affermation, a sharing of experience, a statement of all that is 900d, Positive, challan9in9 and special about bein9 Gay or Lesbian."

...I, (age 60), attended a workshop presented by SAGE, (Senior Action in a Gay Environment, a New York orginization since 1977). Naturally, P-FLAG is mainly concerned about our Gay and Lesbian children - but we must not forget that Gays and Lesbians do 9row up and even 9row old - and still are often forced to be "invisible". As a member of the American Assn. of Retired Persons, (AARP), years, I had read the letter from a Gay man asking that some occasional recognition be given, in their Publication, MODERN MATURITY, to the Gay members of the group. I also read, with dismay, two viciously homophobic responses the next issue's "letters" section. Now I have learned that SAGE has tried Place a Paid advertisement in the magazine but were told it was "objectionable". I plan to follow up on SAGE's request that People write or call Henry Fenwick, Editor of MODERN MATURITY, 3200 East Carson St., Lakewood, CA 90712, complain about the refusal to accept the SAGE ad, the Publication of letters, and the deliberate ignoring of 10 percent of the senior population being Lespian or Gay. And I would be delighted to think that other P-FLAG members or readers, especially those who are AARP members, would do the same.

From L.A. F-FLAG's newsletter

At our April meeting, Christopher McCauley described his work with the L.A. based FAMILY DIVERSITY PROJECT begun in 1985. It uncovered the fact that 85% of the households in the U.S. do NOT consist of a working husband, an at-home wife and children. Contrary to Popular belief, they consist of a raimbow of diversity: Foster families, Gay/Lesbian couples, stepfamilies, diverced Persons, unmarried roommates, multi-generational families, single Parents, Guardianship families, etc. Therefore, they look more like 'The Golden Girls' than 'Ozzie and Harriet'! He spoke of the California Family Registry in which hundreds of diverse households have registered with the Secretary of State's office as a family, recieving a certificate declairing them "The family of..." or "The household of...", for example. Christopher and his subject were so facinating that we all stayed until the lights (literally) went out!

BACKLASH

[MILWAUKEE] "I don't care if you queers die of AIDS or dismemberment. do us all a favor though and hurry it up, OK? I hope Dahmer gets off on a technicality."

That anonomous letter, Postmarked July 26th, was mailed to Terry Broghmer, Executive Editor of The WISCONSIN LIGHT.

Dan Schramm, President of GLINN, (Gay/Lesbian International News

recieved the followin9 messa9e on his answerin9 machine the same day:
"Hello, this is Jeffry Dahmer. I want your head in my refri9erator. Call me."

These are but two examples of the homoPhobic backlash which has decended uPon members of Milwaukee's Gay community since the Dahmer murgers hit the headlines on July 23rd.

Other examples: The PoPular M&M club at 124 Water St. has recieved bomb threats, Patrons of Gay bars in the 200 block of S. Second street have been Pelted with with e99s, Bartenders and Patrons of Gay bars have detected a notable increase in shouts like "Fa99ots!" and "F**kin9 Queers!" from cars crusin9 near Gay bars. On July 30, two uniformed Milwaukee Police officers walked into CLUB 219, harassed Patrons, then approached the bartender and demanded to know the location of "the S&M rooms where PeoPle are tied up and tortured."

Can July 30, Dave Orly, a lobbyist for the Milwaukee Folice Association, made the comment, in the Presence of at least 5 or 6 witnesses, "People ask the Police if it's hard to look at at the [Dahmer] murders. It's a lot harder for me to see a ten month old baby with it's head beat in. I feel more sorry for the baby. The baby was completely innocent... These Gays all choose the lifestyle which gets them killed." One of the witnesses of the above comments was Ken Scott, a legislative aide at the capital. He was so disturbed by Orley's homophobic blame-the-victum mentality that he told The WISCONSIN LIGHT that he was willing to be fired from his job for reporting the incident.

Mark Belling, gabshow host on WISN-AM, has also made numerous inflamitory comments. Example: On July 23, the day the murders hit the headlines, he stated: "Most Gays I've come in contact with are not happy - it's why they're always lashing out at society: Indicate that's what's at work with homosexual overkill, it's the ultimate in lashing out..." On July 29, Belling called Dahmer's victums (Paraphrased): "a handfull of PeoPle who made bad decisions and suffered because of it."

There is also a move afoot by several groups, including Gays, Lesbians and Afro-Americans, to get sponsors, most notably COLDERS, to withdraw advertising from Belling's show. Belling was hired to generate "hate mail", so chances of getting him fired may seem slim, however according to Dan Fonz of ACT-UP, "I don't think people realize how easy it would be to take Belling off the air. No sponsor is going to want to publicly admit supporting [Belling's] ideas."

EDITOR'S COMMENT: It only takes ONE mass-moron like Dahmer an (almost literal) heartbeat to undo work it has taken thousands of Lesbians, Gays and open-minded "others" YEARS to build up: Open-mindedness, trust and friendship with the "straight" community, and an atmosphere of equality for all. How long will it take us to rebuild what Dahmer, Belling, and other bigots have destroyed?

PERSONAL NOTE TO MARK BELLING: If I were you, fells, I would re-think managed attitudes, or you might feel lucky to be giving farm & market reports or world in South St. Paul, Mn.!!!

GUILT?

'Editorial

This editor, (not Gay), has mever lashed out in this Publication, however, between Jeffry Dagmer's unbelivably warped mind and the Poisonous bigotry propigated by WISM's Mark Belling and others, (which will likely DIRECTLY result in serious injury or death for MANY MORE people in the Gay community), things have gotten to the Point where I can no longer contain myself!

I REFUSE to Patronize ANY sponsor who advertizes on Belling's show encourage my readers to do likewise, and tell them WHY! I am sending a copy this newsletter to WISN-AM for the General Manager, Program Director AMD Mr. Belling to read. WISN was granted a license by The Federal Communications Commission TO BROADCAST IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST() and I hardly feel that inciting the population of Southeastern Wisconsin to Harm ten pergent of that Population is "in the Public interest"! Perhaps letters addressed to the F.C.C., complaining about Belling's bigotry and the very dangers that his verbal Poison causes to citizens in the community MIGHT effective in changing WISM's on-air Policy! May 'Belling the bigot' soon learn what the unemployment line is like, and be blackballed in the broadcasting industry! In my opinion, by directly or indirectly condoning and encouraging hatred and violence against Gays and Lesbians, Belling has done MORE damage than Dahmer! Dahmer killed less than 20 victums, bi9otry esPoused by Bellim9 others could easily cause many times that number of deaths! Ι'n mЭ every case in which someone assaults a homosexual or PERCIEVED homosexual because of Belling's bigotry, Belling should stand the same legal charges as the attacker! It is too bad that criminal charges for inciting Great bodily harm cannot be brought against Mr. Belling and other bigots! (Shall we encourage our lawmakers to write such laws?) The same applies to ultra-fundamentalist cler99 who Preach similar Poison from the Pulpet "...in the name of God!!!" The God that I know and worship says "LOVE thy heighbor as thyself," not "Kill those whom you do not understand!". I shall now dismount my soap box.

LETTER TO THE EDITOR

Plass murder has as much to do with sexual orientation as rafe does with love or child molestation does with affection.

If either suspect, [Dressler in Racine and Dahmer in Milwaukee], in these grusome murders had sex with their victums has not been established. And if one or both did, what does it prove? Boes it prove they were homosexual? Evidence in the [Bressler] trial portrays the suspect as a loving family man, a good husband and father. In other words, a straight man. The attempt by the press to label him a homosexual in order to shift the blame from their own violence-consumed reality is not only an insult but a sham.

Regardless, these two suspects certainly were not and are not Gay. Being Gay is being Proud. It is the ability to love a Person of the same sex, to share love, affection and life. If sex was involved, it was not a matter of making love. It was a matter of violation, like rape and child molestation, an assault bred of anger, of hate, of corrupt power, of humiliation, and of intense homophobia. It was not "homosexual overkill," it was HOMOPHOBIC overkill.

Violence, murder and dismemberment - the ultimate violation of the human body - is not the Product of love, of being an 'out' and Proud Gay Person. It is the Product of a society that fears two men loving each other, but accepts the widespread depiction of of murder and complete barbarity on the small and silver screens. It is the Product of self hatred engendered through the opposition of Gays BY SOCIETY AND CHURCH THAT WANTS SEXUAL CONFORMITY AT ANY COST. It is the Product of violence on the streets and dysfunction in the home, It is, quite simply, the Product of a society that heterosexuals have forced upon us.

Gay People have not created the society in which we all live. We have not created a society that drives thousands of Gay and Lesbian teenagers to commit suicide.

We have not created the society that causes 9an9s of heterosexuals to 90 out to find Gays to brutally attack and murder. We have not created the society that looks away when heterosexuals rape Lesbians to "make them strai9ht." And most certainly we have not created the society that turns out mass murderers. We have been the victums of it.
