PrideFest itself is a remarkable example of the power of this community spirit. Just two years ago, the festival faced a financial crisis. Through the work of a dedicated



Premium Beverages & Dance Pavilion Get An Upgrade

When you are dancing the night away in PrideFest's Dance Pavilion this year, you may notice a few changes to your dance, drink and entertainment experiences.

This year PUMP! will produce the Dance Pavilion music, according to PrideFest Board President Scott Gunkel.

PUMP! is a dance music production team headed by promoter Gregg Hutterer and DJ John Murges. "PUMP! produces popular roving 'Gay Nights' at nightspots like Three, Trocadero, and Hi Hat, to name a few," Gunkel said. "They have a great following and use many DJs from the Chicago area as well, which will attract more people from the Chicago area."

PUMP! also wants to attract people from other places in the Midwest. Hutterer said they plan to include DJs from all over the Midwest in Sunday's lineup.

Saturday's lineup will employ PUMP!'s "tag-team" DJ method, in which three DJs, John Murges, DJ Plez and DJ Kelly, take turns playing music at the pavilion, Hutterer said.

"It makes it more interesting for the crowd because they get different styles of music," Hutterer said. "We hope that if we mix it up there's going to be something for everybody."

In addition to their music selection, other features will be upgraded in the Dance Pavilion.

"PUMP! has designed a new lighting and sound environment that will make the dance experience much more vivid and enjoyable," Gunkel said. "They blend music and scenery that encompasses the entire dance crowd, an experience that must be seen to believed."

To accommodate PUMP!, PrideFest has enhanced its sound and lighting equipment to ensure that the quality is excellent, according to PrideFest Co-producer Michael Hall. He too agreed that the PUMP! experience is something to see.

"PUMP! has some surprises, so everyone needs to check this out each night," Hall said.

Pridetini's & More Premium Beverages

In addition to enhancing the Dance Pavilion's music, PrideFest, listening to the suggestions of its patrons, has enhanced the alcohol selection available on the grounds.

"Ask and we shall answer," Gunkel said. "This year PrideFest has done two major additions to the adult beverage line up. First, PrideFest has added a Martini or 'Pride-tini' bar, that will be located at the northernmost bar in the Dance Pavilion ... Second, upscale wine choices will be offered in the southernmost bar, as well as at a separate wine bar near the Activity Pavilion."

The Martini bar offers Effen Vodka, Hendricks Gin and Sailor Jerry's Spiced Rum, while the wine bars will feature five wine selections from Intermezzo Wine Bar.

In addition to all of these changes, Gunkel said that PrideFest patrons should still expect their traditional Dance Pavilion offerings, including Potawatomi Free Bingo, Bloody Mary's and Mimosas for morning drinkers, leather and diva reviews, and the Drag King show.

Getting to Know the Grounds

Key Points of Interest

Miller Lite Pavilion

Located in the heart of the PrideFest grounds, the Miller Lite Pavilion presents a non-stop lineup of national and regional acts.

Rainbow Pavilion

Newly expanded this year, the Rainbow Pavilion is at the northernmost point of the PrideFest grounds (towards the Art Museum). Stop by for great entertainment throughout most of the weekend.

Dance Pavilion

During the day, the Dance Pavilion provides a large, covered space for free Bingo, the Diva Review, the Annual Leather show, the Miltown Kings, and great comedy. At night, the space becomes the hottest outdoor dance party on Lake Michigan! Located north of the main gate entrance and fountain area.

Stonewall Pavilion

PrideFest is more than just a great party. It's also a place to engage the community and discuss issues like LGBTQ equality, advocacy, health and history. The Stonewall Pavilion is located along the lakeshore behind the main food vendor area. Don't miss the important events scheduled for this stage!

Activity Pavilion

The wide-open space and bleacher seating of this staging area provides plenty of room for youth and family activities. The Activities Pavilion can be found south of the food vendor buildings and to the east of the Williamsburg Marketplace.

Milwaukee Gay Arts Center Pavilion Cafe' and Wine Bar

Located just north of the Dance Pavilion, the Arts Pavilion features performances and LGBT history exhibits throughout the day in a cafe setting.

Family Play Area

Take a break with the kids in the playground, located between the Miller Lite Pavilion and the lakeshore.

Food Vendors

Several restaurants and other food vendors can be found to the east of the Miller Lite Pavilion area and throughout the grounds.

Williamsburg Marketplace

Need to shop? We can help. Visit the Marketplace to the south of the Miller Lite Pavilion for a variety of business vendors.

Organizational Vendors

Learn about and support local and national LGBT-friendly organizations. The organizational vendor booths can be found along the center boulevard stretching from the main gate entrance to the lakeshore, as well as at other locations throughout the grounds.

ID Bracelet: Get carded, stay carded

PrideFest takes a pro-active approach to preventing underage drinking at the festival. The festival uses ID bracelets to allow patrons of legal drinking age to purchase alcoholic beverages throughout the festival grounds without being carded every time. All patrons who wish to drink alcohol must show an ID to demonstrate that they are of legal drinking age. Bracelets will be available near at the north end of the Miller Lite Pavilion (west of the VIP deck) and near the Activity Pavilion (south of the food vendors). Watch for signs marking these areas.

Bracelets are required to be worn by everyone who will be purchasing or drinking alcoholic beverages at all times. Those who are not wearing a bracelet while drinking alcohol will be challenged, escorted to the ID station and asked to provide proof of age.

Braille entertainment schedules will be available at the wheelchair/stroller rental area near the Main Entrance.




Sign Language Interpreters
