Last year's concert was very well received by the 300+ in attendance. This year's concert will include the Artemis Singers, an all women choir, appearing for the first time this year. The concert will also feature the Band and Chorus separately and together in the finale.

SF Chorus Cancels

Despite the announcement in last month's Newsletter to appear in Madison on July 13, the San Francisco Gay Chorus has decided to cancel its 1982 National Tour due to finances, according to concert organizers in Madison. The Chorus lost several thousand dollars in 1981 as a result of that year's National Tour. Therefore, it will not be possible to tour the country as it had planned this year. The Madison organizers will return any contributions received as soon as possible. An alternative entertainment is being searched for at the present time for the July 13 date.
