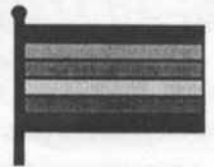

Bi and Trans Inclusion Growing in Gay and Lesbian Groups

NGLTF adds Bi and Trans to mission statement, puts Bi on board; Milwaukee HRL members vote to include Bi's and Transgenders

The National Gay and Lesbian Task Force (NGLTF) recently adopted bi and transgender inclusive language in both their vision and mission statements. The new NGLTF mission statement, drafted on Sept. 13 states: "The National Gay and Lesbian Task Force works to eliminate prejudice, violence and injustice against gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgendered people at the local, state and national level."

Lani Ka'ahumanu, a long-time bi activist and "the soul of the bisexual movement," was appointed to the NGLTF Board of Directors. Ka'ahumanu, who was once thought of as the "lesbian who fell from grace,"

is the first strongly bi-identified person to sit on the NGLTF Board. It is believed that she will lobby for an organizational name change to - see *Inclusion*, p.3

5th International Bi Conference is April 3-5 in Boston

On the weekend of April 3-5, 1998, bisexuals friends and allies from around the world will gather in Boston, Massachusetts to participate in over 100 workshops, panels, papers and performances at the 5th International Bisexual Conference at Harvard University.

This year's conference theme is "One World, Many Faces: Unity & Diversity in Bi Community, Queer Community & the World." Presenters from England, Germany, Finland, Canada, Argentina, Scotland, Australia, The Netherlands and the USA will lead topics about every conceivable issue in regard to bisexuality.
